### **SYLLABUS EVENTS**

Lectures	Our aim is to prove lectures on a wide range of subjects including member's own work, practical demonstrations and external lecturers.
	Occasionally the club benefits from the attendance of "prestige lecturers". These are lecturers who are experts in their field and to cover the additional cost, members from local photography clubs are also invited to attend for a small fee.
Workshops	A themed evening to assist members in gaining a specific skill such as Macro Photography, Still Life, Portraiture, etc.
	Workshops run externally to the club are also promoted to provide members with additional learning opportunities. These are usually at an additional cost.
Challenge Evenings	Challenge evenings take place c. once per month and will focus on a particular subject, which may be linked to a previous lecture or workshop evening.
	Members may submit 1 image each in either print or projected digital images (PDIs) – as specified per Challenge. The images are then scored anonymously and a critique provided by experienced members of the club. New members will find critiques to be light-hearted and informative.
	Scores for each challenge are added up and an award is presented to the member with the highest total score over the sequence.
Workroom	Prior to submission of work into the Annual Exhibition two workroom evenings are held – one for print and one for PDI.
	Members are encouraged to put forward a maximum of 2 images that they may be considering entering for the Annual Exhibition to obtain some initial constructive feedback prior to submission.
Project Evenings	Evenings consist of c.6 available slots for members to share a selection of work on a particular theme. There are print and PDI Project Evenings and the format required will be specified in the syllabus.
Outings	Throughout the Summer months, the club looks to arrange a number of outings and challenge evenings. Previous events have included a trip to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park, One Hour Challenge, Huddersfield University, etc.
Inter Clubs / Battles	There is a long history within the club of battles held with other photographic clubs in the district. These may be either print or PDI format and this will be specified ahead of the competition.

	Members are encouraged to submit work which will be called for in advance of the event, and our club competition selection		
	panel will decide which work is included.		
	External judges are appointed by the host club to judge the work submitted.		
Annual Exhibition	Our annual event takes place in Spring / Summer and usually		
	runs for a minimum of two weeks or more. The event is usually held in the Huddersfield Art Gallery.		
	It comprises of both competitive and non-competitive sections with competitive sections being judged by a number of external judges prior to the opening of the exhibition when winners are announced and certificates and trophies awarded accordingly.		
	Images can be submitted across a range of categories and there		
	are Beginner, Intermediate and Experienced sections. All members are encouraged to participate in our most prestigious event.		
Judges Feedback	A number of evenings are included in the syllabus for external		
Evenings	judges to visit the club and provide their feedback and commentary on the competitive submissions for our Annual		
	Exhibition event. These evenings are a great opportunity to gain		
	an understanding of what judges are looking for in a winning		
	image.		
Sunday Social	A series of outings and events taking place outside the normal		
	club schedule on a Sunday. Previous Sunday Socials have		
	included visits to Hardcastle Craggs and a deer rut in the Peak		
	District.
